Hike to History

Celebrate the Dedication of the Appalachian Trail Museum
Saturday, June 5, 2010 – 11:00 am

Please join us for a hike-in to the A.T. Museum's Dedication. Our journey to witness this history-making event begins at Kings Gap Environmental Education Center on South Mountain - 1,200 ft elevation - at the trail-head for the Buck Ridge Trail. The 6 mile route to Pine Grove Furnace State Park tops off at 1,525 feet at the 1.75 mile mark before descending to reach the gentle, rolling terrain of the 3 mile homestretch.

Who There is a limit of 150 hikers. Registration will close once this limit is reached or on May 28, 2010, whichever occurs first.

What Proceeds will benefit the Appalachian Trail Museum – the first museum dedicated to hikers and hiking.

The registration fee includes:

- Light, cold breakfast treats and drinks at the Check-in
- Preferred seating for the A.T. Museum's Dedication ceremony
- A special edition A.T. Museum commemorative patch
